Parish Paths Partnership Scheme (P3)	Shirley Anglin (PRoW Officer for Essex County Council) notified the Parish Council that we can enter a Service Level Agreement in the summer 2022. The application was submitted December 2021. No further communication received on this at the moment in spite of repeated emails.	
FP1	Off Bombose Lane around Bombose Farm The fingerpost remains obscured from sight by dense hedging. The kissing gate at the edge of the road can get overrun by brambles and nettles. This has been cut back but <u>the finger post remains a 'live' issue on the ECC 'report a problem' site.</u>	2777380 15/05/2022
FP5	From the BR22 Ferriers Lane in a westerly direction towards Hornes Green The verges of the woodland section of this footpath have been cleared of nettles and brambles. Having eventually secured this reinstated footpath, it will require regular maintenance to ensure that it doesn't become overgrown again.	
FP7	From Beautiful You in a northerly direction to the passive crossing at Kings Farm Lamarsh The narrow corridor which runs alongside the Secretaries property has been cut back by the 'Footpath Warden' and subsequently by the Parish Contractor. Persistent nettles are overgrowing the footpath from the adjacent private land and will require regular checking over the summer months.	
FP8	From Colne Road opposite White Dragon Archery in a northerly direction to Ferriers Cottage The section approaching the brook and the footbridge has been strimmed back by the Footpath Warden but needs monitoring.	
FP13	Footpath off Fishpits Lane opposite Polstead Farm leading along Lamarsh Park There is no fingerpost at this point or any indication that this is a PRoW. Still awaiting the site to be assessed during future scheduled inspections. A report with a photo has been made again to ensure that this longstanding issue receives attention (<u>still 'live'</u>).	2777141 15/05/2022

FP14/BWY15	<p>Footpath from Ravensfield Farm to Polstead Farm Damaged old-style concrete fingerpost.</p> <p>Byway from Ravensfield Farm to Hornes Green Both PROWs originate from the same point. The Byway has no finger post. These reports have been removed from the Interactive website and are now logged as items to be assessed during future scheduled inspections. A report with photos has been submitted again to ensure that this longstanding issue gets resolved. <u>This report remains 'live' on the 'report a problem' site but no action has been taken yet.</u></p>	2777143 2777139 15/05/2022
FP21	<p>From Master Farm along the field margin to the Cambridge Brook The entrance to the footpath, where the dog waste bin is positioned, has been cut back and subsequently thoroughly cleared by possibly the landowner</p>	
FP23	<p>From Hobb's Well, south-west to Craig's Lane along a field margin The short fenced-in corridor alongside the property Hobb's Well has been kept clear of nettles and will continue to need regular attention over the summer months.</p>	
FYI	<p>Quiet Lanes Suffolk. As previously reported, the QLS Admin Team understand, all Wave 3 lanes (St Edmunds Lane, Hollow Lane, Arger Fen) have passed through the consultation process. Suffolk Highways continue to finalise their report to the SCC cabinet member for Transport who will sign the legal designation notices on behalf of SCC. A further update for Wave 3 parishes will be provided once the QLS Admin.Team have received confirmation that the designation notices have been signed. It is likely this will coincide with a public announcement in the EADT. Wave 4 Lanes (Smallbridge Entry, Mill Hill)will go out for formal public consultation on 18th July. Letters will be distributed to the affected properties and notices put up on the road itself, on the Parish Council website, in the Parish magazine and in the village noticeboard.</p>
